



Brussels Airport (Zaventem) → Maastricht

In order to travel from [Brussels Airport \(Zaventem\)](#) to Maastricht Railway Station you can use the train. The airport railway station is located below the terminal (basement level 1) near the arrival hall and the departure hall.

Tickets cost around €14,- and the trip will take 1.5 hours – 3 hours depending on the journey and the transfers.

It is possible to [plan your travel](#) in advance. Always check for updates concerning your travel route.

Step 1. Travel information

Step 3. Select your journey

Select the journey you want and click on 'confirm selection'.

Step 4. Booking

- E-ticket: print e-tickets at home or open your tickets on your smartphone via the SNCB Europe app;

In either way, by filling in your first and last name and by clicking on 'confirm delivery method' you can complete your personal details and choose your payment method.

E-TICKET

With an e-ticket, you can immediately board the train without having to pass by the ticket counters first. After you've made your booking, you'll receive a confirmation mail with a link to your e-ticket(s). You can then **choose** how to use your e-ticket(s):



Option 1: print your e-tickets at home

Print each ticket on a sheet of A4 paper before departure. You'll then have your tickets immediately after you've made your booking.



Option 2: open your e-ticket on your smartphone

Add your booking to the **SNCB Europe** app via **My tickets** and use your smartphone to display your ticket!
