### How to get to FPN

Our faculty can be reached by bicycle, train, bus, car, etc. With the trains and busses stopping right in front of our main building at *Universiteitssingel 40*, you have many options to choose from. Via 9292.nl you can calculate what is the best mode of transport for you.

### Picking up your UMcard

Did you receive an email that your UMcard is ready? Then (and only then) you can pick it up at UM SPORTS (see below).

The UMcard is your official ID within the university. Only with this card you can enter the UM buildings, parking lots, and other facilties. The UMcard can be used to pay at several food and beverage outlets and vending machines within UM. But you can also use it to identify yourself at test locations, for printing at UM, or to borrow books at the library.

#### **UM SPORTS**

Close to our faculty, you'll find UM SPORTS. This university sports centre offers a wide variety of indoor and outdoor sports, top-notch facilities, generous opening hours and a welcoming atmosphere, your fitness aspirations have no limits. <u>Take a look at what's on offer</u>!
