## The Background of the Conference

The world has been changed significantly since the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic, which has reshaped the public governance models and changed the ways of social interaction. Globally speaking, the pandemic has generated intense debate over the issue of public health security, through which the role, nature, and effectiveness of regulation can be further scrutinized. Moreover, market turmoil and financial instability caused by the pandemic have also proven to be a fruitful field for law and finance scholars to investigate. From a domestic perspective, China's economic and social development has entered a new stage and need to be systematically assessed and analyzed. As a powerful theoretical approach, law and economics can be relied on to understand and address public governance problems in the post-pandemic era.

Against this background, an international conference titled as *Law and Economics in the Post-Pandemic Era* is proposed to be held on 10 June 2022, Beijing, by the School of Law and Economics at China University of Political Science and Law. Scholars from China and overseas are invited to participate in this conference, which will be divided into four sessions: (1) Frontiers in Law and Economics; (2) Law and Finance; (3) Regulatory Law and Economics; and (4) Empirical Legal Studies.



## 会议背景介绍

新冠疫情深刻改变了我们所处的世界，重塑了公共治理模式和社会交往方式。从全球来看，疫情引发的公共卫生议题，凸显了监管的重要性，也引发了关于监管作用、本质及其有效性的讨论。伴随新冠疫情发生的市场波动和金融风险为法律与金融学者提供了新的研究主题。从中国来看，经济和社会已经进入新的发展阶段，新时代的政策工具是理论界面临的重要研究课题。法与经济学由于自身的学科特点，可以成为分析和解决后疫情时代中国和世界经济、社会和环境治理问题的重要分析工具。

在此背景下，中国政法大学法与经济学研究院拟组织以“后疫情时代的法与经济学”为主题的学术会议，邀请国内外法经济学学者参会交流与研讨。会议主要围绕以下四个主题展开：（1）法与经济学的理论前沿；（2）法律与金融；（3）监管的法律经济学分析；（4）法律实证研究的发展。



## **An Introduction to School of Law and Economics**

School of Law and Economics (SLE) is a research institute at China University of Political Science and Law. It was formerly known as Center for Law and Economics, which was founded in 2005. SLE is dedicated to using economic theories and methods to examine China's legal system and thereby providing policy recommendations for legal reform. Four topics have been chosen by SLE as the keystone projects, namely Economic Analysis of Law, Law and Finance, Market and Regulation, and Law and Economics of the Transitional Period. SLE now has twelve full-time faculties, including four professors, three associate professors and five assistant professors. In addition, five scholars from Europe are affiliated with SLE as part-time professors.

SLE faculties have published over 20 books and approximately 160 papers, which appear in peer-reviewed journals, such as *Zhongguo Faxue* (China Legal Science), *Jingji Yanjiu* (Economic Research Journal), *Guanli Shijie* (Management World), *Journal of Economic Surveys*, *European Business Organization Law Review*, *International Review of Law and Economics*, *European Journal of Law and Economics* and *Economics of Governance*. Moreover, SLE faculties have undertaken more than 200 research projects commissioned by various institutions, such as National Social Science Fund of China, Humanities and Social Sciences Research Fund of the Ministry of Education, Asian Development Bank, People's Bank of China, State Administration for Market Regulation, Financial and Economic Committee of National People's Congress, Legislative Affairs Commission of National People's Congress, etc.



SLE has also established close relationships with many prestigious overseas universities, such as University of Chicago, University of California, Berkeley, Maastricht University, University of Edinburgh, University of Bologna, etc. Over 60% of graduate students in SLE have an experience of visiting overseas universities, and some of them pursue a doctoral degree abroad after they graduate from SLE.



## 中国政法大学法与经济学研究院简介

中国政法大学法与经济学研究院（以下简称研究院）系中国政法大学在编科研机构。研究院前身为法和经济学研究中心，创立于 2005 年。研究院的宗旨是运用经济学的理论和方法分析中国的法律制度和法律问题，进而为中国的法治建设提供政策建议。研究院下设四个研究方向，分别是法律的经济分析、法律与金融、市场与监管、转型经济与转型法律。目前研究院有专职教师 12 人，其中教授 4 人、副教授 3 人、助理教授 5 人。另外，研究院还从海外知名高校聘请了兼职教授 5 人。研究院教师均具有博士学位和海外名校的学习经历，其学科背景涉及法学、经济学、金融学和统计学等多个领域。

自成立以来，研究院教师共出版学术专著 20 余部，在国内外学术期刊，如《中国法学》《经济研究》《管理世界》、Journal of Economic Surveys、European Business Organization Law Review、International Review of Law and Economics、European Journal of Law and Economics 和 Economics of Governance，发表论文 160 余篇。研究院教师还承担了国家社科基金、教育部人文社会科学研究项目、全国人大财经委、全国人大法工委、中国人民银行、国家市场监督管理总局和亚洲开发银行等机构委托的科研项目 200 余项。

研究院与美国芝加哥大学、加州大学伯克利分校、荷兰马斯特里赫特大学、英国爱丁堡大学和意大利博洛尼亚大学等学校建立了紧密的学术联系。研究院的学生中，60% 以上拥有海外学习经历，部分研究生还选择在海外学校攻读博士学位。

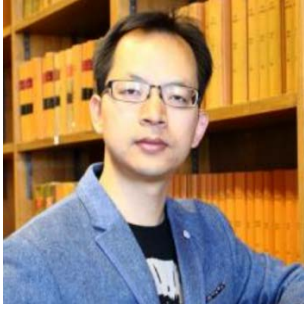

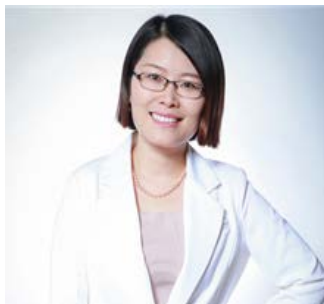
