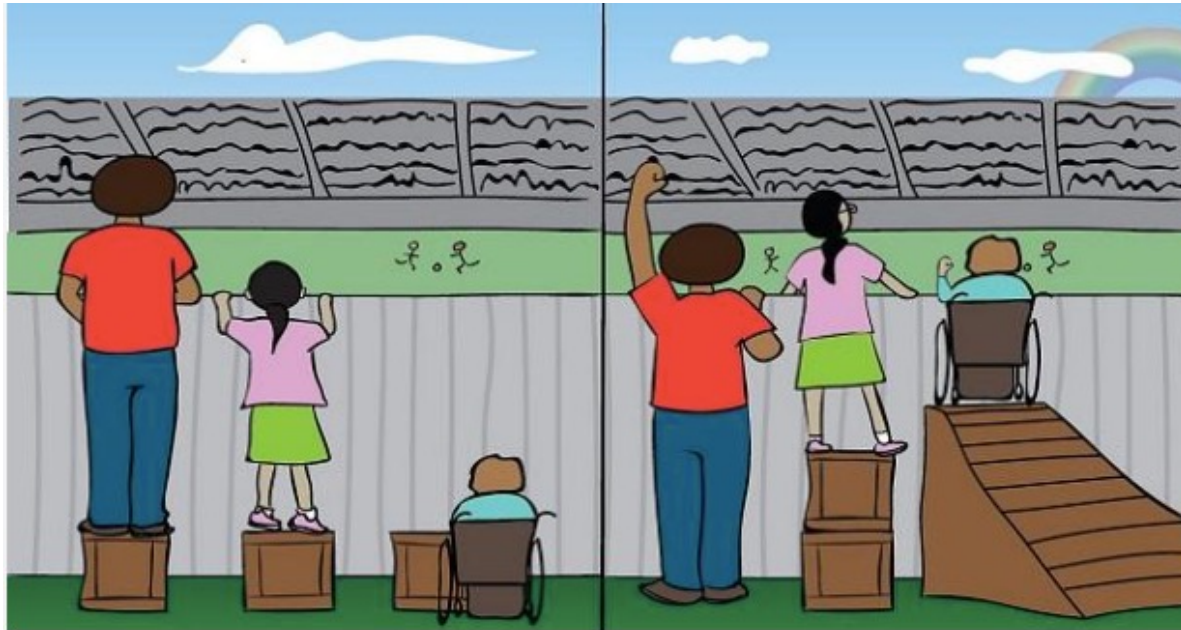

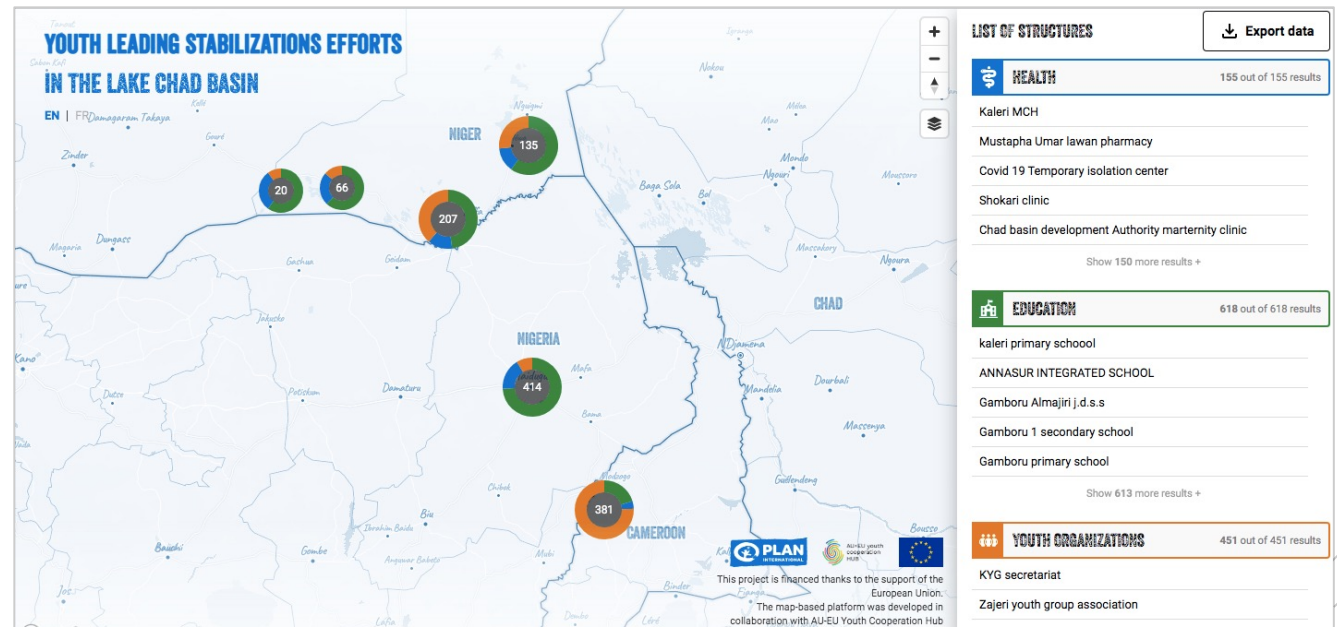

Guiding Questions

Food for thought to get you started

- **Expertise:** Who are you considering an expert? Based on what?
- **Agenda-setting and prioritization:** Who gets to define the problem? How is its urgency and importance established?
- **Participation and inclusion:** How are you bringing diverse voices and experiences into decision-making? Who is not at the table? Why?
- **Final decision-making:** Who is in the driver's seat? Who gets the final say on what, who, where & how?
