Re: New business processes for Maastricht University suppliers

Dear valued supplier,

At Maastricht University (UM), we are working to optimise our ordering and payment processes. This will help to make the cooperation with you as a supplier more efficient and effective.

UM is currently implementing its Integrated Operational Management programme. To this end, we are cooperating with SAP Ariba, a cloud-based purchase-to-pay software solution. Soon we will introduce the Ariba Network as a platform for the communication of digital business documents such as purchase orders, order confirmations and invoices. This will also enable us to order through catalogues in an automated and user-friendly manner.

In this letter, we inform you about the impending changes. Your cooperation is important to make this a success.

What does this mean for you?

SAP Ariba will be introduced in different phases ('waves'). You are receiving this information because your company is linked to the next wave. This means that, as of **January 2022**, you will be asked to carry out transactions via the Ariba Network. In this message you can read about how best to prepare.

What are the advantages for you?

- Streamlined, digital processing of purchase orders and invoices, making it easier to do business with UM.
- > Accurate and timely payments of invoices.
- Lower operating costs, less time needed to solve problems and less paper consumption.
- Option to view the payment status of invoices directly in the Ariba Network or to receive status updates by email.

Are there costs involved for you?

To collaborate via the Ariba Network you need an account. There are two types of accounts: standard and enterprise. The standard account is free of charge; there are costs associated with an enterprise account. Which account you need and what costs are involved depends on several factors. How will we support you?

A dedicated UM project team has been set up to provide you with information and guidance during this transition. As a first step, we would like to invite you to one of our **information sessions for UM suppliers** in mid-July 2021.

During these sessions we will provide more information about our transition to the Ariba Network and the benefits for you as a supplier. We will also explain when action will be required of you. What should you do now?
