 - 10 years after graduation

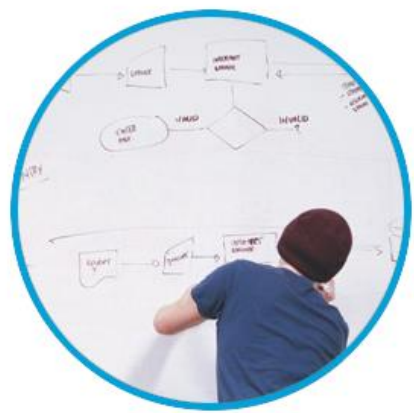

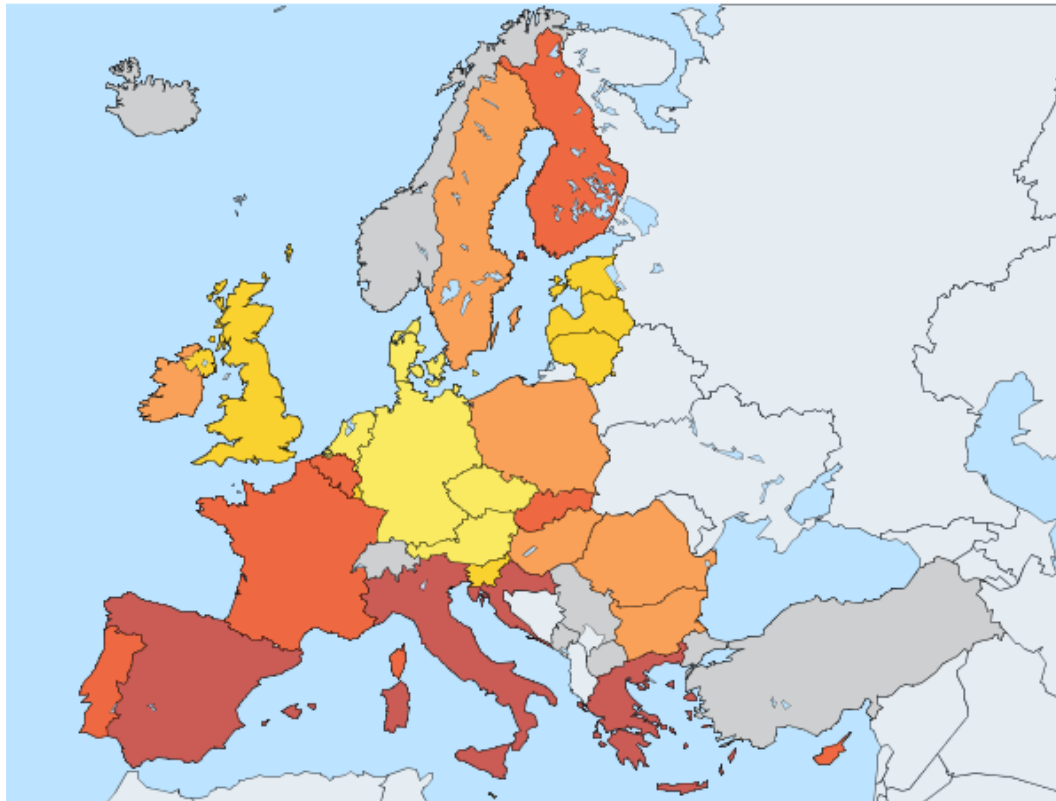

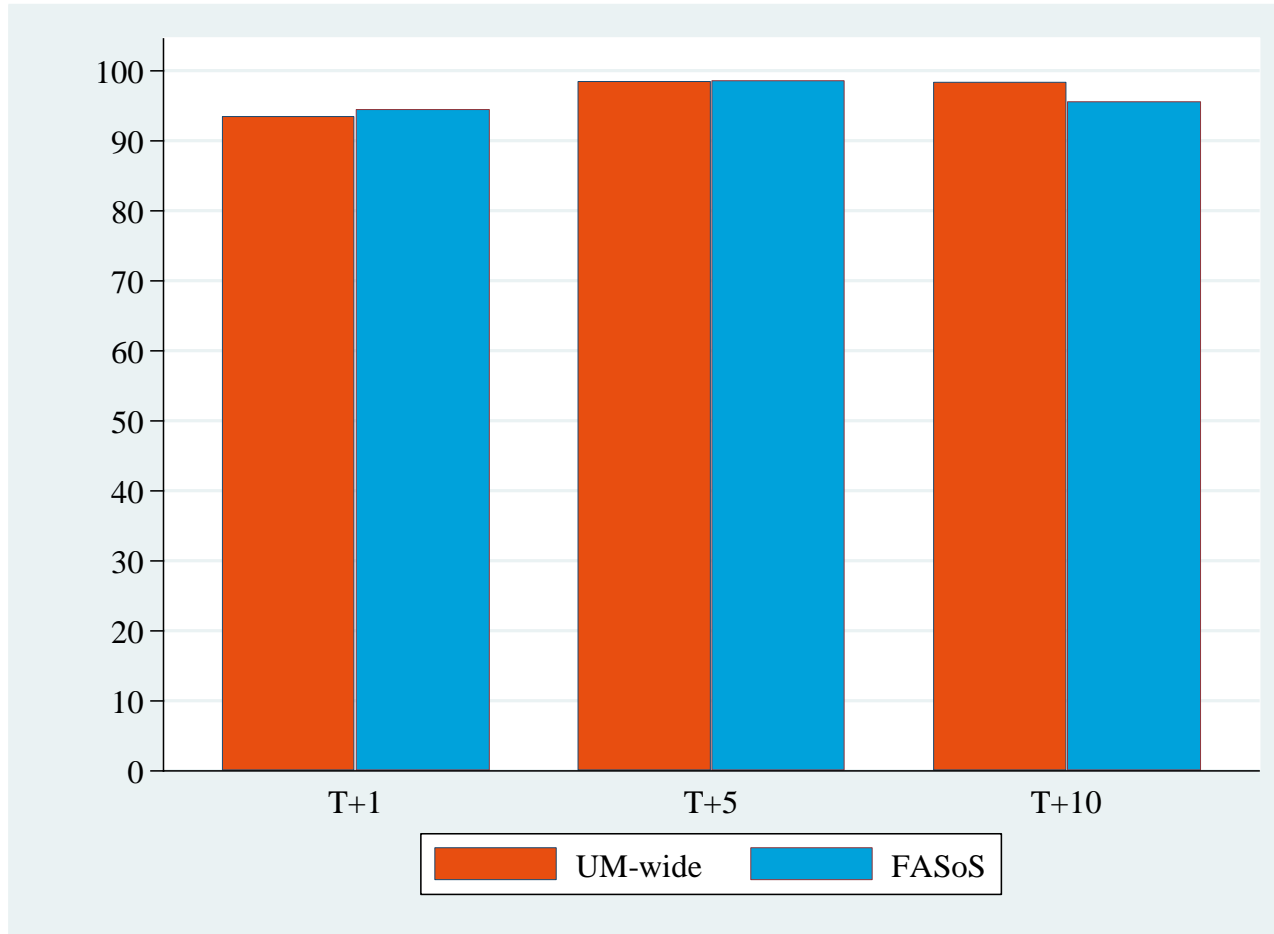

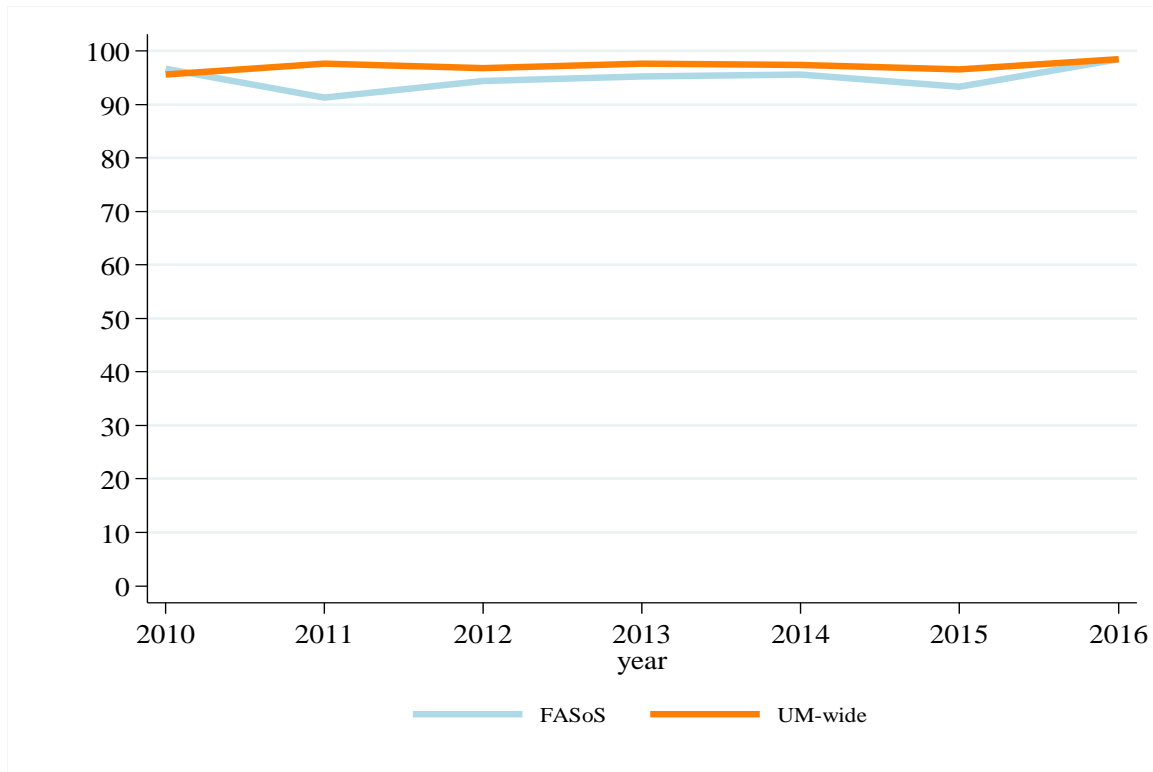

Trend in employment 5 years after graduation



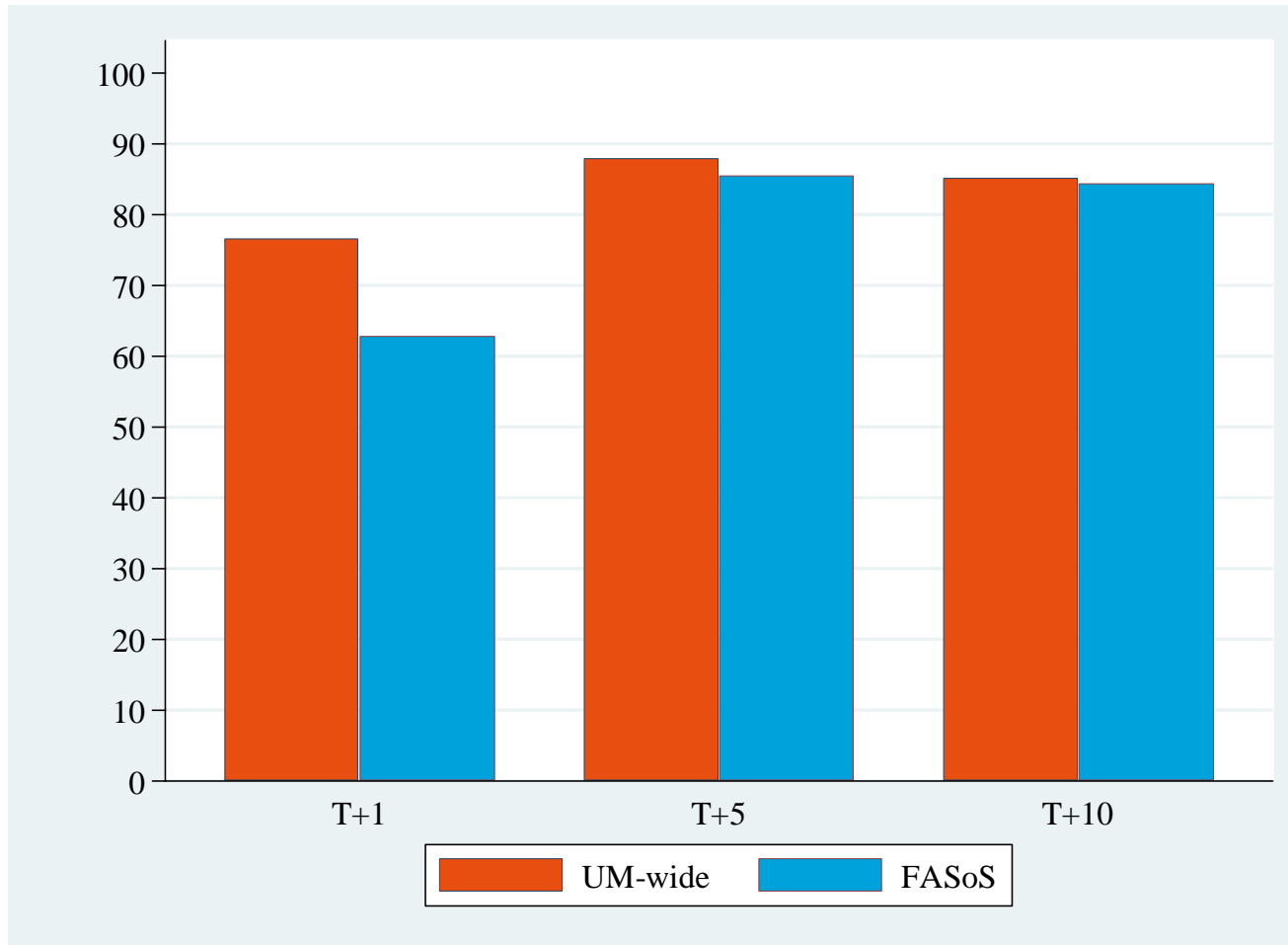
→ Unemployment of FASoS graduates fluctuates strongly with business cycle

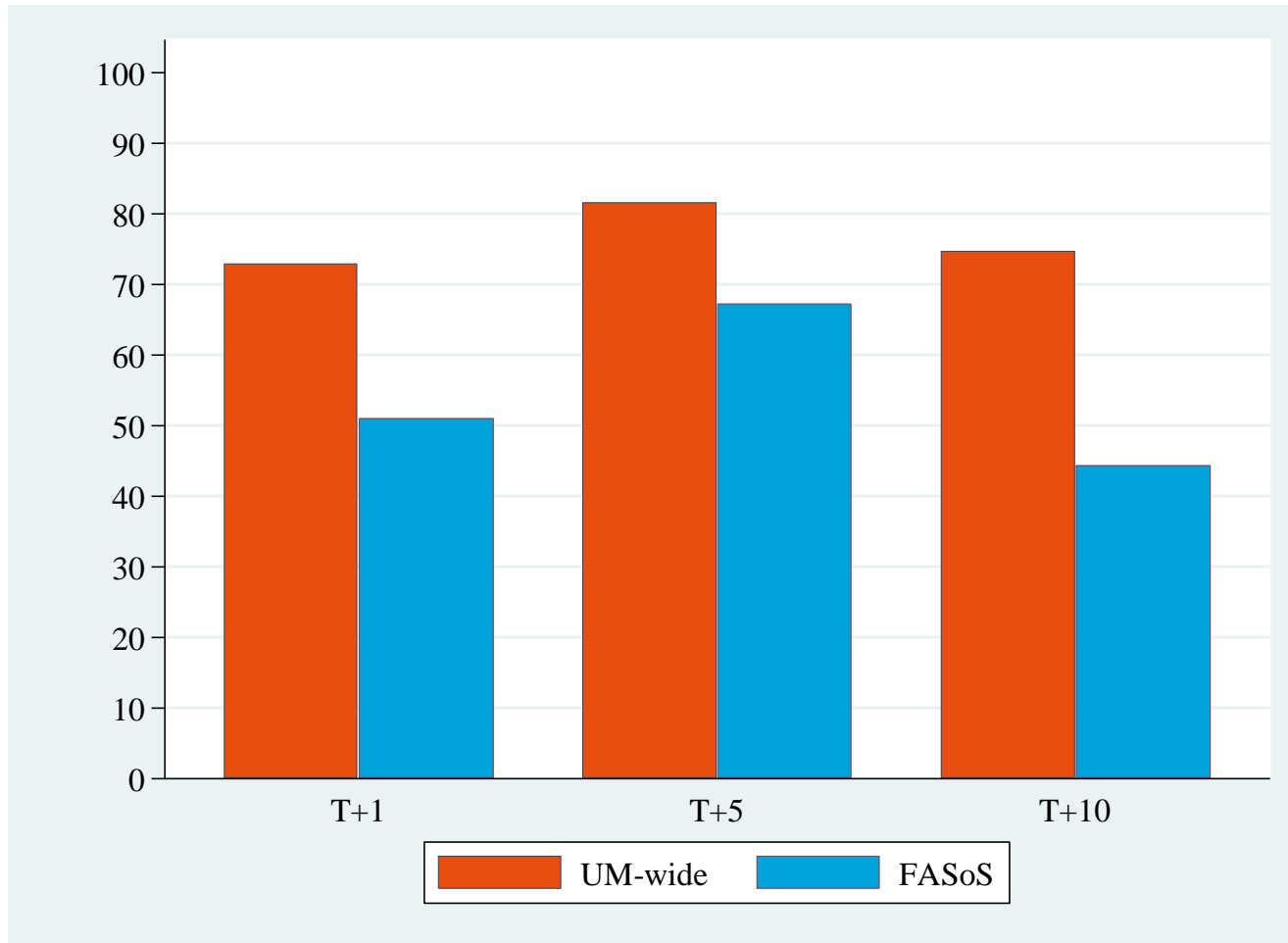

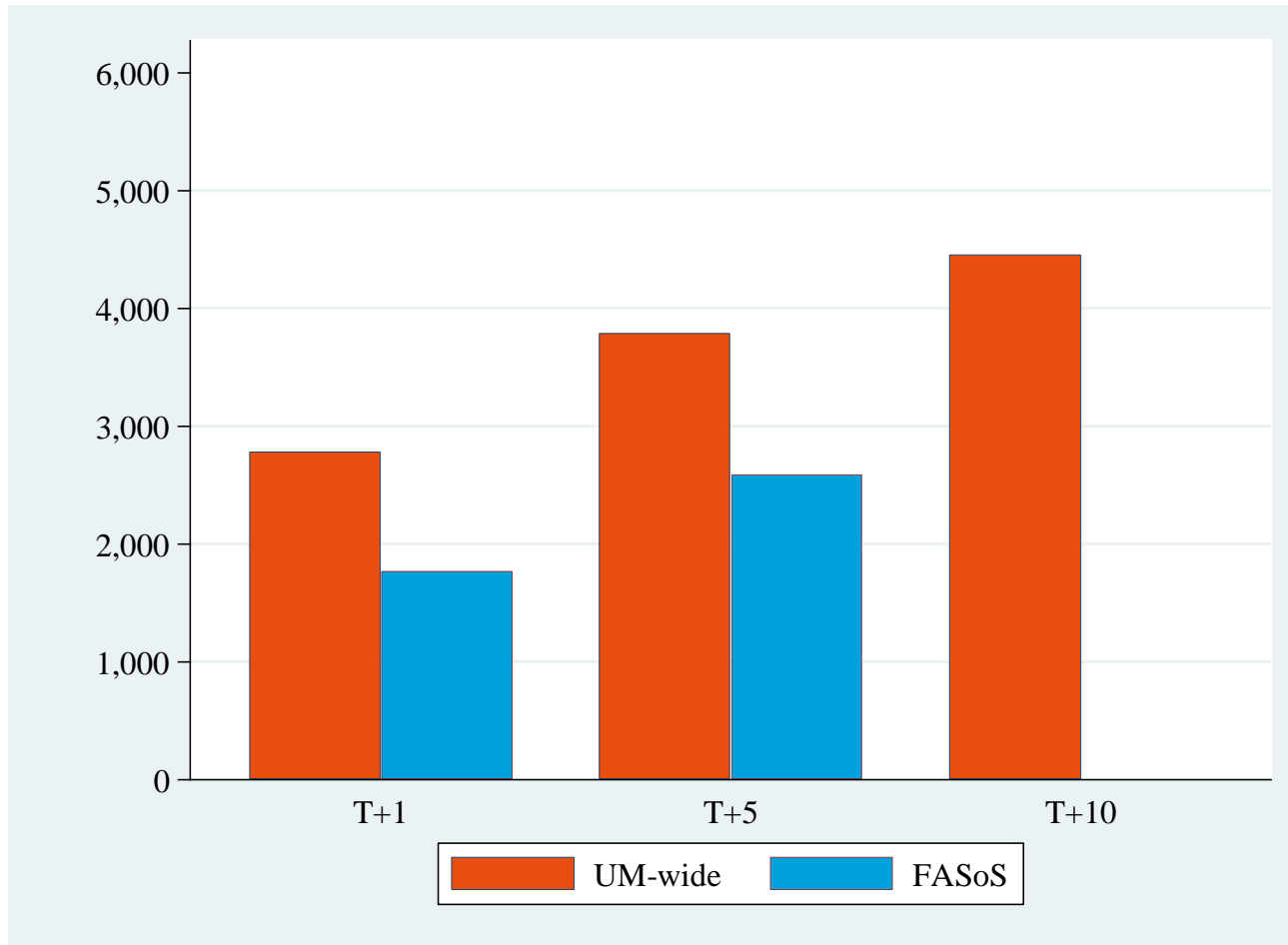
Finding a job at university level



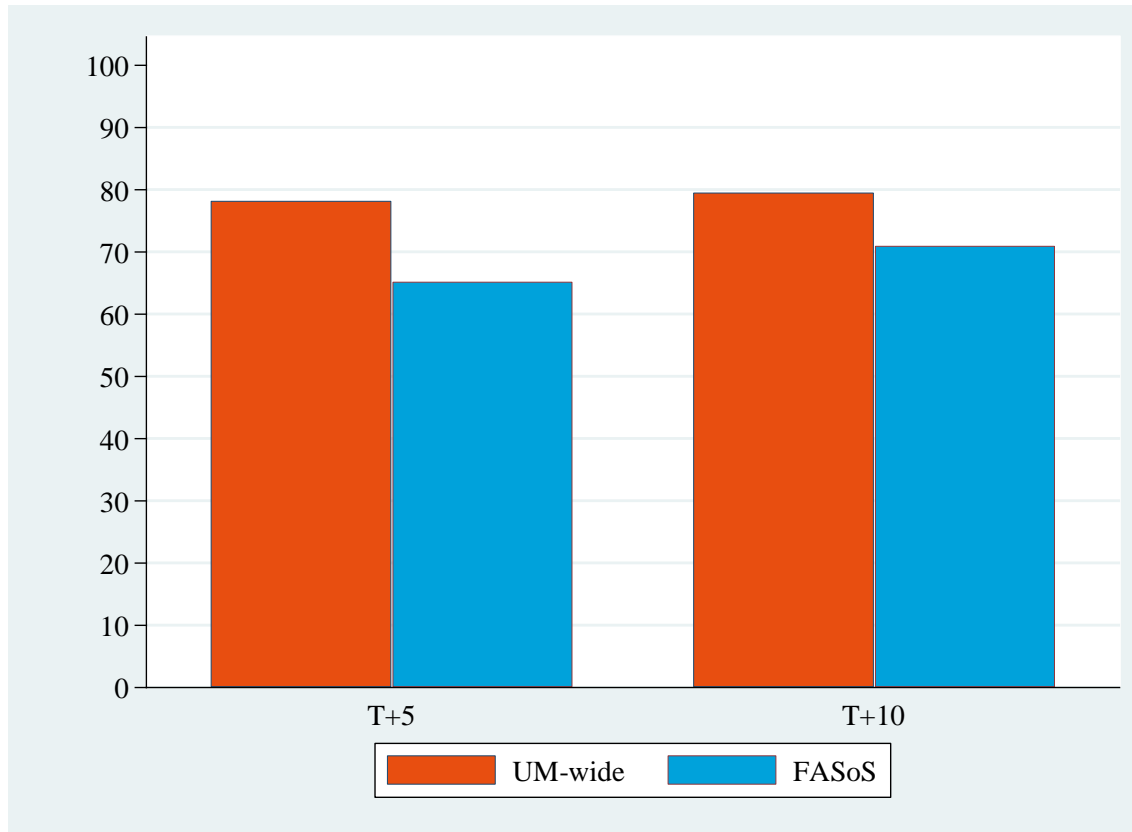
Finding a job within field



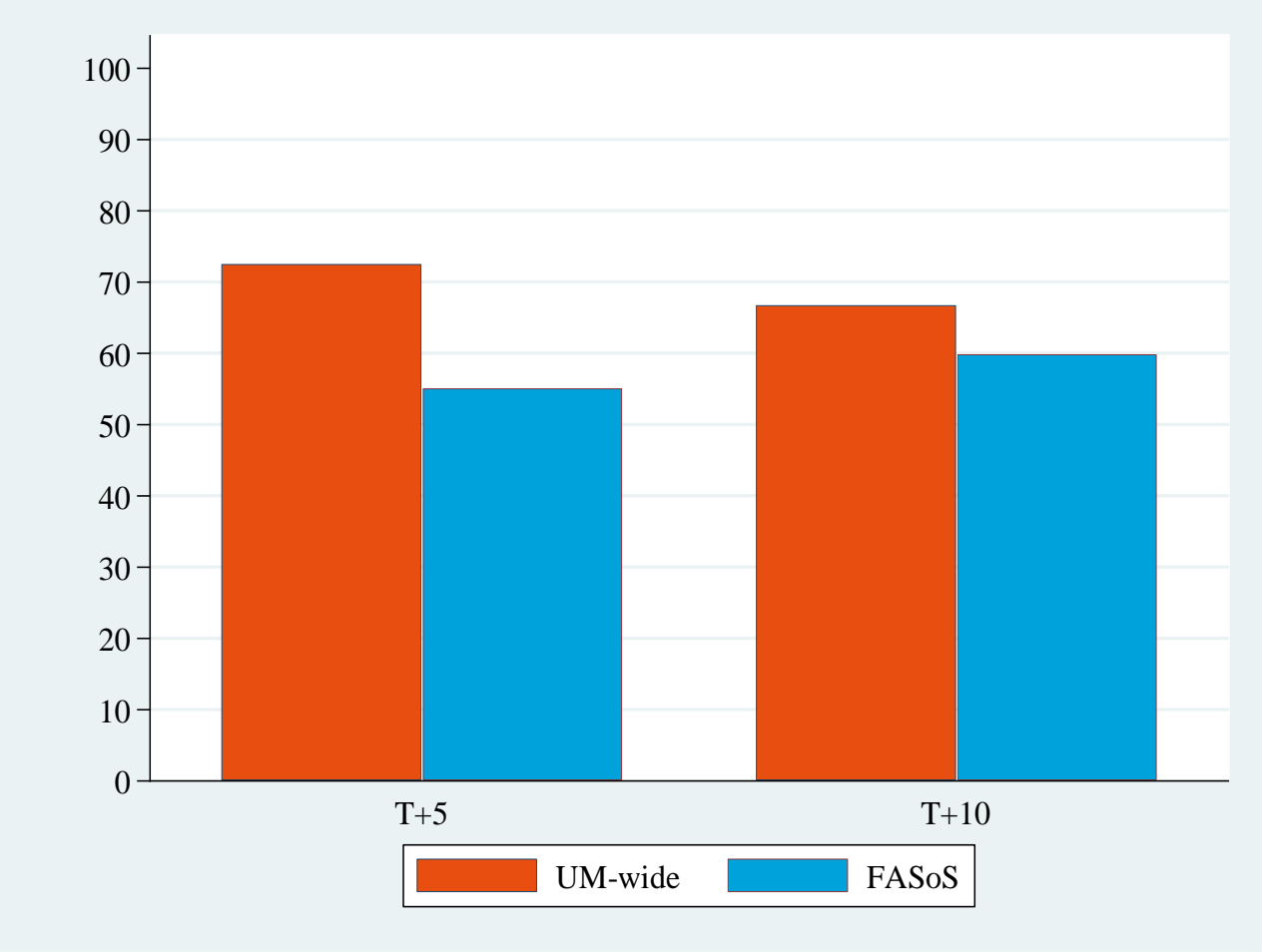
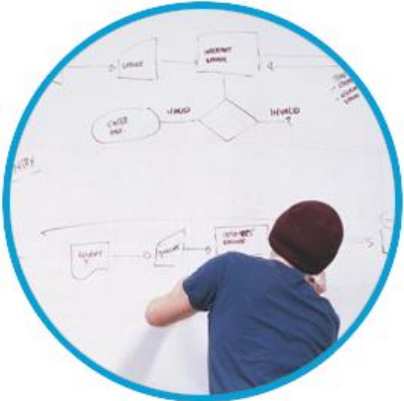
Gross monthly income

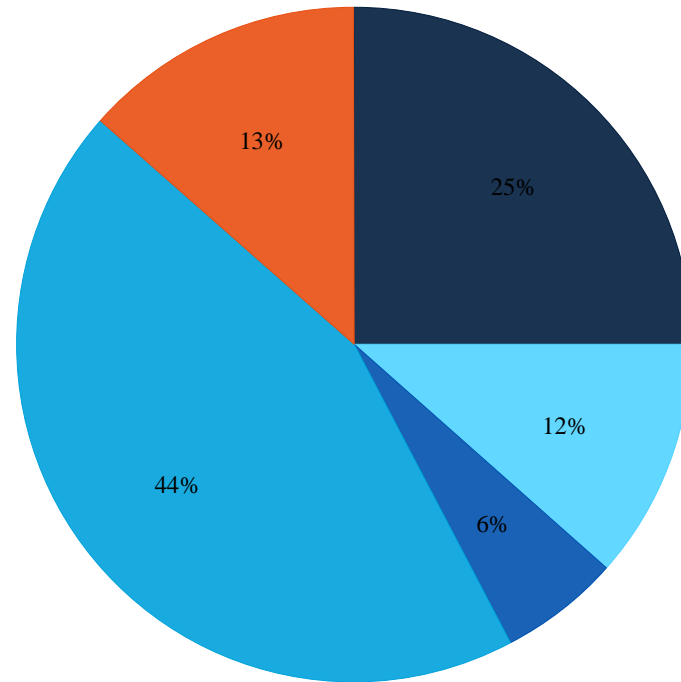

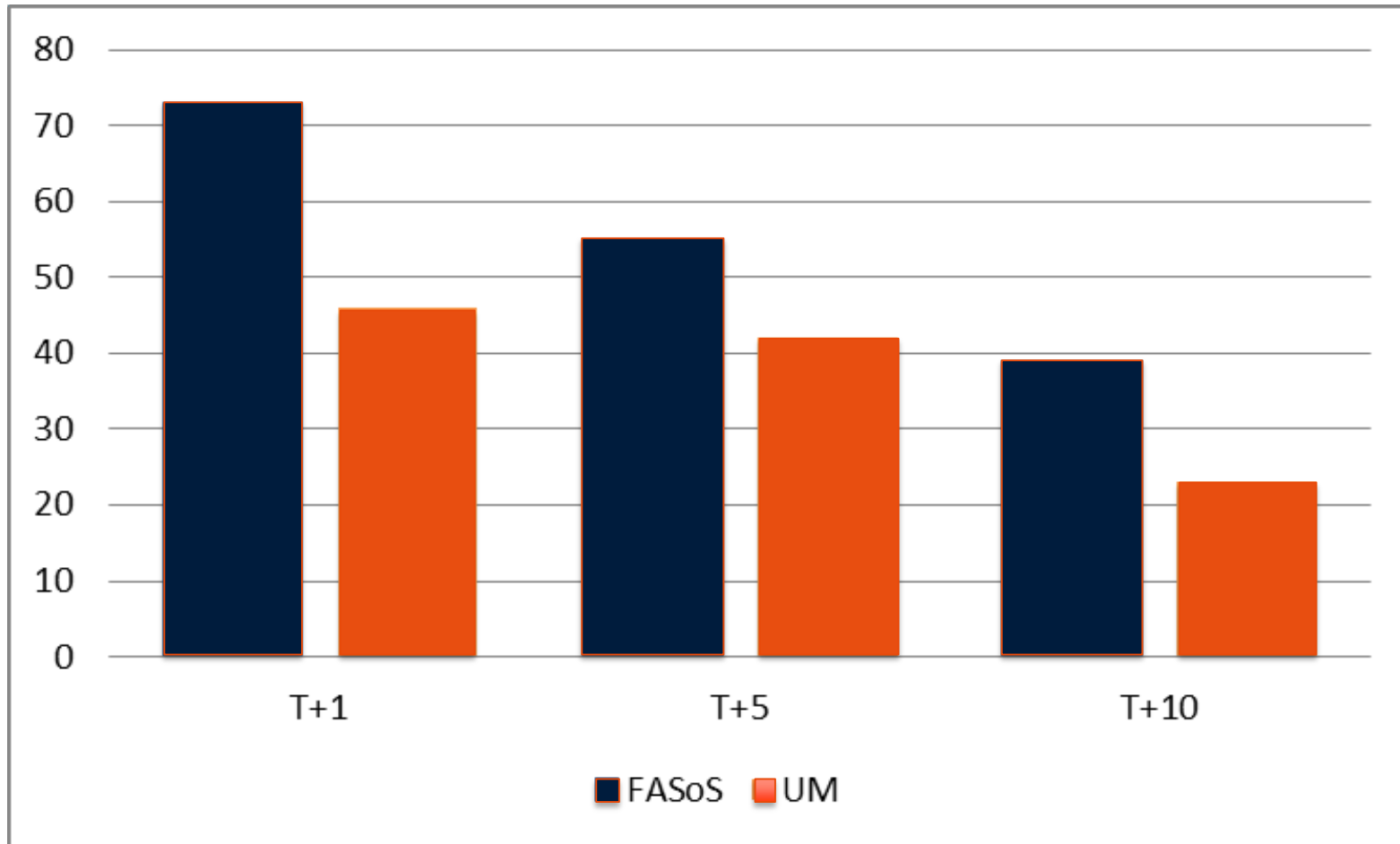

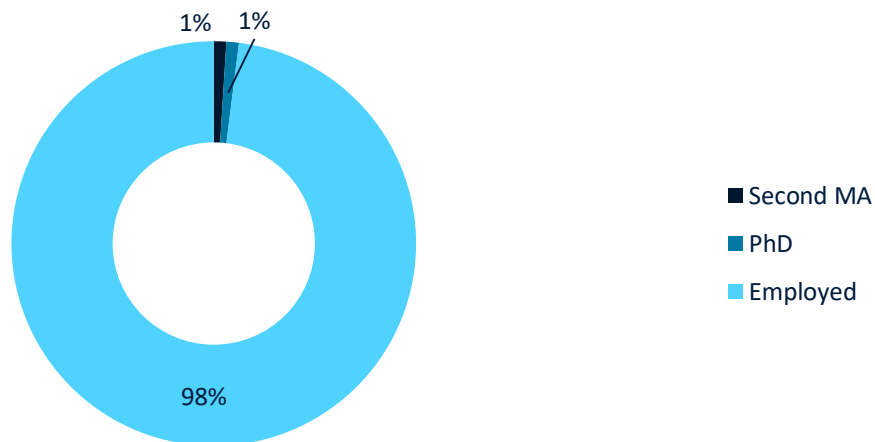
