



**i** The departments are the home base of the academic staff. They provide education and conduct research within the framework of the education, examination and research programmes of the Faculty of Law and UM. Together with the Faculty Board, the department heads form the Management Team (MT).

The research institutes and groups are responsible for carrying out the faculties research programme.

The Graduate School of Law is dedicated to training PhD researchers and honours students.

The Staff Group Education is responsible for supporting teacher professionalisation, educational development and educational quality assurance.

The Law Research Support Office is the primary point of contact for support on research related issues for academic staff, such as funding applications; and supports the Faculty Board in establishing and implementing research policy.

The Faculty Office supports the operational management of the faculty and provides services in the areas of education, research, housing and facilities, finance and marketing and communication. Together, the 9 teams optimally facilitate education and research.
