PROGRAM AI in teaching assignments

Dr. Ghislaine van Mastrigt (Assistant Professor, Maastricht University).

But what do we do if AI is doing most of the writing; which assignments are most affected and how should we change our teaching assignments to meet our learning goals?

AI in journal articles

Prof. John Marsden (Editor-in-Chief, Addiction). *Discussant: Dr. Ludovic van Amelsvoort* (Associate Editor, Journal of Clinical Epidemiology). Short

presentation followed by discussion: in scientific writing, AI can be used in an ethical way, but the difference between proper use and for example plagiarism, can be difficult to detect. Are journal editors afraid that many articles become fabricated in the era of AI? What measures can be taken to prevent this?
