Lindau Nobel Laureate Meetings

The Lindau Nobel Laureate Meetings aim to encourage the exchange of knowledge between different generations of scientists, consolidate international networks, and inspire both young researchers and Nobel laureates. The theme of the Lindau Meetings alternates between the three Nobel Prize scientific disciplines: physics, chemistry or physiology/medicine. The Lindau Meeting on economic sciences is held every three years

Subject areas 2024: Physics, 2025: Chemistry, Economic Sciences

Award: During the Lindau Meeting Days with Nobel Prize Laureates, young scientific talents have the opportunity to meet colleagues from all over the world and to talk to Nobel Prize Laureates

Career Phase: Students, PhD candidates and post-docs researchers

Beijerinck Premium for virology

The Beijerinck Premium, established in 2002, is awarded every year to a talented early career researcher working in the Netherlands on excellent virus-related research and in doing so is an example for other young virologists

Award: EUR 25,000 to spend on virus-related research

Career Phase: Young scientist who are conducting original and outstanding virus-related research and obtained their PhD between three and eight years before the Award was presented

Nominator: Dean, full professor, director

- Economische en bedrijfswetenschappen
- Maatschappijwetenschappen (sociologie, politicologie, antropologie, bestuurskunde)
- Gedragwetenschappen (psychologie en pedagogische wetenschappen)
- Rechtswetenschappen
